

Holy Trinity School Uniform Guidelines 09-10

Girls

Casual Uniform

- *plaid jumper (K-4)
- *plaid skirt (5-8)
- *forest green polo shirt with logo (K-8) (short or long sleeve)
- *twill khaki pants (optional K-8)
- *khaki shorts (K-8) cuffed
- solid brown, khaki or black belt with pants and shorts (no decorations, holes, studs, etc.)
- *plaid skort (optional K-8)
- *navy cardigan sweater (optional K-8)
- *navy sweatshirt (with or without hood) with insignia (optional K-8)
- *navy hooded jacket with insignia (optional K-8)
- *navy fleece jacket with insignia (optional K-8)
- solid white cuffed socks (must have full size cuff above shoe, no rolling, scrunching of socks, or folding under feet) or white. *forest green or *navy knee socks (K-8) (no decorations)
- solid white or black laced athletic shoes (K-8)
- *navy bike shorts—may be worn under skirts/jumpers for modesty only
(Polo shirts must be tucked in at all times.)

Dress Uniform

(to be worn on Mass days or as announced)

- *plaid jumper (K-8)
- *plaid skirt (5-8)
- *forest green polo shirt with logo (K-8) (short or long sleeve)
- *plaid skort (optional K-8)
- solid white cuffed socks (must have full size cuff above shoe, no rolling, scrunching of socks, or folding under feet), or white. *forest green or *navy knee socks (K-8) (no decorations)
- solid white or black laced athletic shoes (K-8) (see above)
- black or white laces for athletic shoes (K-8)
- *navy sweatshirt (with or without hood) with insignia (optional K-8)
(Polo shirts must be tucked in at all times.)

PE

- *navy blue knit shorts with logo (optional K-8)
- *khaki twill shorts (K-8)
- *forest green polo shirt with logo (K-8)
- *green Holy Trinity t-shirt with logo (optional K-8)
- *Holy Trinity sweatpants (optional K-8). Sweatpants to be worn on PE days only.

*Must be purchased from Dennis Uniform Company.
(Forest green and navy knee socks must be purchased at Dennis Uniform so all color shades are the same.)

Boys

Casual Uniform

- *khaki twill pants (K-8)
- *khaki twill shorts (K-8)
- solid brown, khaki or black belt with pants and shorts (no decorations, holes, studs, etc.)
- *navy cardigan sweater (optional K-8)
- *forest green polo shirt with logo (K-8) (short or long sleeve)
- *navy sweatshirt (with or without hood) with insignia (optional K-8)
- *navy hooded jacket with insignia (optional K-8)
- *navy fleece jacket with insignia (optional K-8)
- solid white crew socks (K-8) (no rolling, scrunching of socks, or folding under feet)
- solid white or black laced athletic shoes (K-8) (NO blinking lights, hiking boots, platforms, roller skates, or decorations)
- black or white regular laces for athletic shoes (K-8)
(Polo shirts must be tucked in at all times.)

Dress Uniform

(to be worn on Mass days or as announced)

- *khaki twill pants (K-8)
- *forest green polo shirt with logo (K-8) (short or long sleeve)
- solid white crew socks (K-8) (no rolling, scrunching of socks, or folding under feet)
- solid white or black laced athletic shoes (K-8)
- solid brown, khaki, or black belt (no decorations, holes, studs, etc.)
- *navy sweatshirt (with or without hood) with insignia (optional K-8)
(Polo shirts must be tucked in at all times.)

PE

- *navy blue knit shorts with logo (optional K-8)
- *khaki twill shorts (K-8)
- *forest green polo shirt with logo (K-8)
- *green Holy Trinity t-shirt with logo (optional K-8)
- *Holy Trinity sweatpants (optional K-8). Sweatpants to be worn on PE days only.

(With the exception of PE class period,
shirts are to be tucked in at all times.)

OVER

NOTE WELL:

- ◇ Some used uniforms are available at the school
- ◇ **ONLY** navy sweatshirt with insignia (purchased at Dennis Uniform) may be worn
- ◇ **ONLY** navy sweatpants with Holy Trinity insignia (purchased at Dennis Uniform) may be worn.
- ◇ Astrocamp sweatshirts may be worn in 6th grade.

GUIDELINES

- ⇒ Only school sweater, sweatshirt or jacket may be worn in the classroom or church. Non uniform jackets may only be worn outside on extremely cold days (over the uniform sweatshirt or sweater, not in place of).
- ⇒ Shorts and pants must be worn at appropriate waistline, not around hips.
- ⇒ In cold weather, plain white turtlenecks may be worn under shirts and plain white tights may be worn under the uniform skirts or jumpers.
- ⇒ Only plain white undershirts may be worn under uniform shirts.
- ⇒ Alterations may not be made to the school uniform, such as shortening skirts or shorts. Shorts and skirts may not be rolled. Skirts and shorts must be a modest length (no shorter than 3" above the top of the knee; 5" from kneeling on the floor).
- ⇒ **NO** make up, glitter, lip gloss
- ⇒ **NO** nail polish, **NO** acrylic nails
- ⇒ Nails must be neatly trimmed to the tip of the finger
- ⇒ **NO** necklaces, **NO** loop or hanging earrings (small stud type only), **NO** multiple bracelets. One thin chain with a cross or medal (religious symbol) may be worn.
- ⇒ **NO** tattoos (temporary or permanent)
- ⇒ **NO** writing on skin
- ⇒ **NO** extreme hairstyles (subject to administrative decision)
- ⇒ Boys neatly trimmed, above the brow, ears, and collar
- ⇒ Natural colored hair only, **NO** highlighting, **NO** dying
- ⇒ Hair accessories must match the uniform
- ⇒ **NO** sweatshirts tied around waist
- ⇒ Only one earring may be worn per ear—in lobes only/ girls only
- ⇒ Sweatpants may only be worn on PE days

"FREE DRESS" CODE:

For safety reasons, school appropriate athletic shoes and uniform school socks must be worn on free dress days.

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

mini-skirts	spandex	short shorts
low-cut blouses	hats	nail polish
crop top blouses/shirts	make up	tattoos
baggy pants	jewelry	spaghetti straps
extreme hair styles	torn clothes	tank tops
t-shirts with inappropriate advertising, language, or pictures		
bare midriffs (shirt must be at least 3" below waistline of pants or skirt)		

CONSEQUENCES:

- When students are in violation of the dress code, a notification will be sent to parents by the classroom teacher. We ask the parents' cooperation insuring future compliance. (Forms must be signed and returned.)
- Students who are not in dress uniform for Mass Day or who have a uniform infraction will be denied "Free Dress" the next time it is permitted.
- On "Free Dress" days students who are not in compliance must change clothes, (parents will be contacted immediately) and /or a student can be denied "Free Dress" the next time it is permitted.
